- Add the new payee: NYC DOF Property Tax. Enter your account number, which is your boro, block and lot, as it appears here: 1-01901-0009. You may also need to enter the address for the Department of Finance. The address is P.O. Box 680, Newark, NJ 07101-0680.
- 3. Schedule your online payment using your checking or savings account
